Day 2: Vienna, Austria - Tour Begins

In Munich, feel the energy of this lively and fascinating city during a tour that highlights Olympic Park; the world-famous Glockenspiel; and Marienplatz, a beautiful square surrounded by shops, restaurants and cafés. Later in the day, arrive at your home for the next two nights - the quaint village of Oberammergau, renow nedfor wood carvings

Day 7: Oberammergau - Innsbruck, Austria - Oberammergau

Enjoy the scenery of the spectacular Bavarian Alps en route to enchanting Innsbruck, located in Tyrolean Austria. Walk through the charming pedestrian streets and see such landmarks as The Golden Roof on a locally guided tour. As you wind through the narrow cobblestone lanes, it is easy to understand why this city was the center of European culture and politics during the 14th century. Today breakfast will be included.

Day 8: Oberammergau - Black Forest

Today fairy tales become reality at a picture stop of Bavaria's most famous castle, King Ludwig's Neuschwanstein. Next you are off to the heart of the stunning Black Forest, a region famous for its artisans who create authentic cuckoo clocks, Hummels and wood carvings. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 9: Black Forest - Zermatt, Switzerland

Welcome to Switzerland! Your first stop en route to Zermatt is at one of the most photographed castles in the world, the Château de Chillon, located on serene Lake Geneva. Later, enjoy a short train ride aboard the Matterhorn Gottard Bahn from Tasch to the relaxing pedestrian village of Zermatt in the Swiss Alps. Take a stroll and breathe in the fresh Alpine air. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 10: Zermatt

Today you have all of Zermatt at your fingertips. You choose how you spend your day! You may choose to explore on foot during a guided w alking tour of this charming city. Day 1: Overnight Flight

Day 2: Vienna, Austria - Bratislava, Slovakia

Arrive in Vienna and meet your local guide who will take you on a short journey to the capital of Slovakia, Bratislava. Settle in to your city center hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax or independently explore charming Old Town in this post-communist city.

Day 3: Bratislava

Delve into the history of this undiscovered city during a walking tour of the "stare mesto," or "Old Tow n." Your local guide will discuss the country's communist past while showing you the city's treasures, including Saint Michael's Gate, the Slovak National Theatre, Mozart's residence, and St. Martin's Cathedral where the coronation of Maria Theresa took place. Then, have free time to explore, relax and perhaps enjoy lunch at a local café. Later, rejoin your guide for a visit to a family-ow ned majolica factory where you will witness artisans at work glazing the colorful pottery. Next, spend some time with a local resident in their home. Embrace this opportunity to discuss the realities of daily life for Slovaks. *Today breakfast will be included*.

Day 4: Bratislava - Vienna, Austria

This morning you have some leisure time in Bratislava before boarding your high-speed catamaran for a trip up the mighty Danube River to Vienna. Along the way, pass the outskirts of the city of Bratislava and the ruins of Devin Castle. Upon arrival in Vienna, transfer to your hotel to meet the rest of your group. *Today breakfast will be included.*
